**1.0 Meeting called to order by Sky Mercier at 7:03 pm. Quorum achieved.**

**2.0 Sky Mercier motioned for approval of the meeting minutes for the January 22, 2026 meeting. This was seconded by Colton Mercier.**

**3.0 Sky Mercier motioned for approval of the meeting agenda. This was seconded by Colton Mercier.**

**4.0 Shayla Heath provided an overview of the Treasurer’s Report.**

- There is \$7,600 in the Main Account with \$3,500 in allocations pending.
- There is \$133,000 in the Gaming Account with \$30,000 in allocations pending.

Shayla reported that from the Gaming Account, \$20,000 needed to be spent this year, due to funding time limits.

**5.0 New Business**

The last “fun lunch” raised \$552.07, and the next (Subway) is on March 12th. Potential fundraising ideas were discussed, including coupon books and card sales.

Bobbi noted that a previously-approved television for the school was no longer needed, and could be taken out of the allocations (\$1000 from the Gaming Account). She also reported that the school’s scooters (\$1618.40 from the Gaming Account) had been ordered and received.

**6.0 School “Asks”**

Votes were held on the following school “asks”:

- For Grade 9 students: \$660 from the Main Account for supplies for a fundraising hot-dog lunch. A vote by exception was held, and there were no exceptions.
- For the Learning Commons: \$9,136.87 from the Gaming Account for new tables and chairs. A vote by exception was held, and there were no exceptions.
